FRIDAY FASTING AND ABSTINENCE - Friday was the first anniversary of the Pope's visit, to mark the visit the Bishops are calling us to reinstate Friday as a day of fasting and abstinence, to identify with the Lord's offering on the cross, in solidarity with those in need and to deepen our Catholic identity. For most of us this means refraining from eating meat, those who do not eat meat as part of their diet could make their witness by abstaining form some other food. We were called to begin this witness last Friday 16th September.
