### TWENTY FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

#### REFLECTION

Today's Gospel begins with a seemingly straightforward question that Jesus puts to his disciples about his identity, and it ends with Jesus revealing how he will build his Church. The Lord uses people, not bricks and mortar, as the "rocks" of his foundation. Jesus builds the Church out of the community of believers who acknowledge Him as "the Christ," and remain faithful to His saving mission. When reflecting upon this Gospel today we remember the gift to the Church of the office held by St. Peter and his Successors as our focus of unity. Rather than a fixed edifice, the Church is a fluidity of persons, living stones cemented together in the mystery of Christ; rooted in Christ nothing else will prevail.
