

PARISH SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME – Preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Holy Communion will begin again in October. Any parents with a child of Year 3 age, not in St. Bernard's School, please see Fr. Steven as soon as possible.

FRIDAY FASTING AND ABSTINENCE - The Bishops are calling us to reinstate Friday as a day of fasting and abstinence, to identify with the Lord's offering on the cross, in solidarity with those in need and to deepen our Catholic identity. For most of us this means refraining from eating meat, those who do not eat meat as part of their diet could make their witness by abstaining form some other food.

**BAPTISM** - Please make initial enquiry to Fr. Steven following any Sunday Mass. A Baptismal Certificate of one of the parents requesting Baptism for their child is now required.
