Giving Thanks!

Pope Francis has appointed Bishop John Arnold, Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Westminster, as Bishop of Salford. He will be the eleventh Bishop of Salford, succeeding Bishop Terence Brain who was appointed in 1997. Bishop John Arnold was ordained Priest in July 1983 and after completing further studies in Rome he was appointed to Westminster Cathedral as a chaplain with responsibilities for the Westminster Hospital in 1985. In 1989 he was appointed as Sub-administrator of

Westminster Cathedral. In 1993 he became parish priest of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and St George in Enfield and remained there until 2001, when he was appointed as Chancellor and Vicar General of the Archdiocese. Bishop Arnold was appointed as an Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Westminster on 3rd February 2006, with responsibility for the pastoral care of the deaneries of Barnet, Brent, Enfield, Haringey, and Harrow. Let us promise to pray for him as he takes up this new pastoral role, and give thanks for the harvest gathered in by Bishop Terence.

We begin our New Sacramental Programme this Thursday: it is a much changed programme and is called "With you always", it is very important that parents and guardians come along, as the emphasis will be on families preparing together. There is a choice of meetings 8-45am and 6pm. Catechists welcome.

Next Sunday we are going to celebrate Harvest at 10am Mass, I have asked the School to help with the liturgy, so come ready to give thanks! If you can bring a tin for the food bank or packets of cereals, or biscuits that would be great and they can be brought up at the offertory: we will also take a retiring collection as our first contribution to the Food Bank promise of support. Don't forget your daily decade of the Rosary, if you can't manage it all! God Bless mjk
