Following on from last Sunday's Gospel we see that as long as Jesus announces glad tidings the crowd responds positively. But when Jesus challenges their narrowness with examples of Elijah and Elisha reaching out to Gentiles they become uncomfortable and angry. Whilst the Gospel is not always comfortable, it is always Good News, but it calls us to move beyond where we are now.

The Gospel is only Good News if we try to live it. Tuesday is the Feast of the Presentation in the Temple, Candlemas. The church traditionally blesses candles which remind us of the light of Christmas reaching into the whole year. By bringing to life the challenge of Gospel, we bring this light of Christ to one another and to those around us.
