REFLECTION

What Jesus teaches in today's Gospel about sinning towards each other rests on the final statement: that Jesus himself abides in the midst of the Church, the community of believers who commit themselves to him and follow his pattern of life. In the Church our communal faith makes us accountable to and for one another. The way we relate to each other in the Church reveals our commitment to Jesus and his living presence amongst us.

Today we begin to use the new words of the Order of the Mass. We can see this change as an inconvenience or we can relish the opportunity to say and listen anew to the words of Holy Mass, the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy Eucharist; the source and the summit of the life of the Church, as the Second Vatican Council describes it. As we are reminded in today's Gospel how we support each other communally will affect the fruit that these changes will produce in our personal lives of faith.

FRIDAY FASTING AND ABSTINENCE – as we approach the first anniversary of the Pope's visit, the Bishops are calling us to reinstate Friday as a day of fasting and abstinence, to identify with the Lord's offering on the cross, in solidarity with those in need and to deepen our Catholic identity. For most of us this means refraining from eating meat, those who do not eat meat as part of their diet could make their witness by abstaining form some other food. This witness begins on Friday 16th September.
