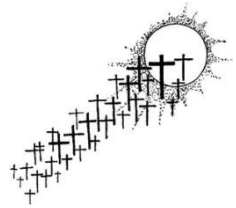

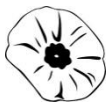
And there is a common thread which unites us all: our need for love and community, for home and acceptance, for love, respect, forgiveness.
