My dear people, I found this quote from the writings of St. Bernard this week, "Brothers and sisters, God reveals to you, as he did to the children, what is hidden from the learned and wise: the true ways of salvation. Meditate on them with the greatest attention. Steep yourselves in the meaning of these Advent days. And above all, pay heed to him who is approaching: think whence he comes and whither it is he advances; consider his purpose in coming, the ripeness of the times, the route he may choose for his approach. Such speculation cannot but be good. Our curiosity is far from being an idle one. The Universal Church would not celebrate this Advent time with such solemnity of devotion did it not contain within it some mystery."

This mystery is the love and compassion of God for us, such a love that he gives us his only Son to be our Saviour. Once again we are preparing to celebrate this mystery of faith, will you be ready or will you allow yourself to be distracted? In your home among all your celebration will there be room for Jesus? Getting ready for a big event means that we have to ensure that everything is in place; last minute things can be a pain! So here is a challenge for you: when did you last got to the Sacrament of Reconciliation? If you think you don't need it, then that is usually a sign that you do! Nearer to Christmas our local Parishes will be having a joint Penitential Service, in the mean time on the Tuesday's of Advent during Exposition I will be in the box ready on stand by duty. If it's been a few weeks, months or even years, don't worry give it a go. New starts are great and can be challenging, so often the peace of mind that we crave for can be won by just being honest with ourselves and sharing it with the Lord, who gives a peace the world cannot give.
