#### **TODAY**

Today's Feast concludes the Christmas season. The gospel speaks of two baptisms. The first is the event the feast celebrates, the baptism Jesus received at the hands of John. The second is the baptism we receive 'with the Holy Spirit.' Jesus baptism revealed him as the 'beloved son of God'. Our baptism reveals us as ones who are saved, renewed, justified and as St Paul tells Titus, 'heirs of eternal life.' This feast then is an epiphany not only of who Jesus is but also of who we are: beloved children of God.

Campaign cards protesting about the advertising of abortion on television can be signed and left here to be sent off together or taken home and sent by yourselves.
