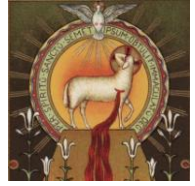

### *I am gentle and humble of heart*

Today's Gospel is an answer to a very simple question: who is this Jesus we follow? What is he like? He tells us himself: he is gentle, and humble of heart. There is simplicity about this Gospel which speaks very clearly to tired hearts. Indeed, it is often the case that we overlook the simplicity of the Gospel message - which is why it is valuable to be as children, constantly wondering and marvelling at the beauty and fascination of Jesus. How much God must love us: the message of salvation is so easy to receive, the promise is so welcome.

This is a Sunday to wallow in the wonder of a God who is  kind and full of compassion.

We pray for the people of the parish of St. Joseph and St. Edward, Longsight and Rusholme, and for Fr. Robert Morland and the SMA Fathers. We pray for the Little Sisters of the Poor and their residents, and for the priests of Opus Dei. We also pray for the Brazilian and Zimbabwean chaplaincies based at St. Edward's, for their parish primary schools and for Xaverian College.
