



"SHEEP WITHOUT A SHEPHERD." This is the simple theme of today's readings. It is interesting that Jesus' reaction to the crowd is one of pity - as he sees their great thirst for his teachings. This is, in a sense, a clear fulfilment of the prophecy we hear in the first reading, where God promises a true shepherd who will care for the people of Israel. Shepherding is a particularly suitable image of God's love and care. The dependency of the sheep on their shepherd, their wandering and drifting without someone to guide them, is also a

suitable image of the people God loves. Our own age also displays sheep without shepherds - a great wandering crowd, seeking something, but not knowing what they are seeking. It is to this flock that the present day followers of Jesus are sent as shepherds.

As we journey together in Hope as a Diocese we pray for the parishes of the English Martyrs, Whalley Range with Fr Morland SMA, and Our Lady and St. John, Chorlton, with Fr. McMahon. We pray for their primary schools, for St. Bede's College and for an increase in the virtues of Faith, Hope and Love.

Fr Michael is going to Lourdes with the Diocese at the end of this week; there is a petition basket with paper and pens in the Lady Chapel.

Pope Francis Tweet: The suffering of so many of our brothers and sisters, persecuted for the sake of the Gospel, is an urgent reminder that we Christians must be more united.
