October month of the Holy Rosary

27<sup>th</sup> Sunday p140

MASS 7/ Creed 11;

Eucharistic Prayer 2(24)

Pope Francis has invited all the faithful, of all the world, to pray the Holy Rosary every day, during the entire Marian month of October, and thus to join in communion and in penitence, as the people of God, in asking the Holy Mother of God and Saint Michael Archangel to protect the Church from the devil, who always seeks to separate us from God and from each other. And, at the same time, to make the Church more aware of the faults, the errors and the abuses committed in the present and in the past, and committed to combating without any hesitation, so that evil may not prevail. We are asked to conclude the recitation of the Rosary with the ancient invocation "Sub tuum praesidium", and with the prayer to Saint Michael Archangel that he protect us and help us in the struggle against evil. The invocation "Sub tuum praesidium" is recited as follows: **We fly to thy patronage, O holy Mother of God; despise not our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers glorious and blessed Virgin. Amen.**

We pray that Mary, the Holy Mother of God, may place the Church beneath her protective mantle: to preserve her from the attacks by the devil, the great accuser. We are asked to conclude our prayer with a prayer of Leo XIII: **Holy Michael archangel, defend us in the day of battle; Be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him we humbly pray, and do thou, prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, thrust down to hell Satan and all wicked spirits who wander through the world for the ruin of souls. Amen**

This week we are praying for the parishes of Our Lady and the English Martyrs, Urmston, with Fr. Mullarkey and Fr. Quiligotti, and Holy Trinity, Worsley, with Mgr Canon Dale. We pray for the Franciscan Missionaries of St. Joseph and for the parish primary schools. May Our Lady of the Rosary bless, guide and protect us always.
