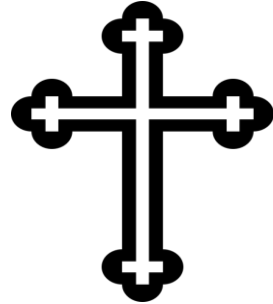
In Flanders Fields by John McCrae, May 1915

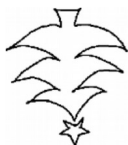
