My dear people, I am still surrounded by boxes and struggling to remember the different security codes: all this is tempered by your many kindnesses to me. Sadly we have had two funerals this past week and two more to come this week, which puts into perspective the worry about boxes and codes! As the month of November speeds by it is good to remember those who have gone before us, and place them before the Lord. Our hope is that God in his goodness will draw them to himself; it is also good to teach the younger generation to remember, for who knows when it will be our turn to join the Holy Souls and need the prayers of those we leave behind? That is why it is good today to reflect on Christ the King, because he is our hope and the cause of our joy. He teaches us through the Word of God and feeds us with the Sacraments, to such an extent that doing good and remembering those less fortunate then ourselves is the most natural thing to do. It is striking that in today's Gospel, neither those we were set aside for heaven nor those not destined, did not know that they had done good, or not done good. As we look towards Advent next week, perhaps one of our aspirations might be, that amidst all the preparations, we are not so overrun so as to forget those nearest and dearest, and to give a thought for those who may be struggling. In the last few days of November we could start with remembering the Holy Souls, then we could give ourselves the opportunity to listen the Word of God, and then to ask for a vision to see beyond ourselves for the good of others.
