'COME HOME FOR CHRISTMAS'

Christmas provides a great opportunity for us to reach out to others, and to invite them and welcome them to our Churches, so here is a simple idea.

'LIGHT A CANDLE,PRAY AND INVITE'

During the season of Advent, lets use the candle stand in front of Our Lady to light candles for those you would like to see come back to a more regular practice of their faith. Please pray regularly for the person you choose, and then to invite them also to come back to church for Christmas. Research shows that many people would come to Church if only they were invited to come by someone who will come with them. So, try your best to invite someone (who doesn't usually come to Church) to come with you to Church this Christmas. For someone who has been away from Church for some time, it usually makes it a little easier for them to come back if they come with someone they know.

A prayer

Loving God, create in us an ever-growing faith, with hearts open and centred in you. Awaken within us the fire of your Spirit, so that your love may fill us more fully, and flow throughout our lives. Increase within us a desire to reach out,

to invite and to share, to welcome and accept. Awaken the faith of all your children, especially those who have grown distant from you, those ready to hear an invitation to the love you alone can bring. Awaken us, loving God, to see the fullness of your grace and peace. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Pope Benedict calls for a 'Year of Faith'.

On 16th October, Pope Benedict called for 'a Year of Faith'. The Year will begin on 11 October 2012, the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of the second Vatican Council, and will come to an end on 24 November 2013, Feast of Christ the King. Its

aim "is to give renewed energy to the Church's mission to lead men and women out of the desert in which they so often find themselves, and towards the place of life, towards friendship with Christ Who gives us life in all its fullness". The Year will likewise be an opportunity "to strengthen our faith in Christ and joyfully to announce Him to the men and women of our time", the Pope said. Pope Benedict went on to say: "In order to be effective evangelisation needs the strength of the Spirit, which enlivens the message and infuses the person who bears it with the 'full conviction' of which St. Paul speaks. The Pope hopes that the Year of Faith and the Synod on the New Evangelisation (2012) will provide a time of reflection and rediscovery of the faith. mjk
