Lateran Basilica MASS 7/ Creed 11; Sunday P. 192 Eucharistic Prayer 3 (p27)



Today is a most unusual feast! The Lateran Basilica is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome 2 an ancient church first built near the walls of the city of Rome by the Emperor Constantine at the beginning of the fourth century. Every Diocese in the world celebrates the feast of the Dedication of their own Cathedral, since the cathedral is the 2mother and head of all the churches in the Diocese (in Salford this

is celebrated on 14th June). The Lateran Basilica, since it is the place where the Pope has his <code>Bcathedram</code> or Episcopal throne, has the title <code>BMother</code> and Head of all the Churches of the City and the World. On this day we both celebrate and pray for the unity of those churches gathered in communion with the successor of Saint Peter. The marbles and mosaics of the Lateran, which together form a splendid and beautiful building, are a sign of the beauty of God's family, the Church, gathered in worship <code>B</code> the living stones of the temple of the Lord. This is a day to reflect on how this building, and cathedrals and churches everywhere are not just meeting-places, but visible signs to the world of the Body of Christ in prayer.

Today we also gather to remember those who have died in service of our Country, and I am minded, that many who died came from Commonwealth Countries and from Ireland, we remember them all today. It is good that some of our School Children who have been doing a project on the First World War will help us with our Liturgy today.

November is also our special month of remembrance of those who have gone before us, our faith teaches us that one day we shall meet them again, but in the mean time we hold their memory in our hearts and prayers, they were precious to us in life, and they are precious to us in death. We remember them in love and ask them to pray for us as they wait on the Lord. God Bless mjk
