Today we celebrate Trinity Sunday, when we give praise and glory to the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is at the heart of our faith, and each one of us was baptised in the name of the Trinity which made us a child of God and a member of the family of the Church. Each Blessing we receive is in the name of Father, son and Holy Spirit: how do we explain it? St Patrick said it was like a sprig of Shamrock one leaf and yet three distinct parts making the one leaf. Another as said it's like the kiss between the Father and Son and the breath between them both is the Spirit; it's from this eternal triangle that all life comes. We find ourselves, because of the generosity of God, caught up in an eternal love story; each one of us is like a kiss on the page of time that eventually is drawn into the presence of God. Is the Trinity a mystery? Of course it is, it is one of those mysteries of faith which we can try to unravel, but its depth is beyond our words and imagining: what we need is a simple faith which will allow us to come closer and closer until we are caught up in the great mystery at the end of our time. Then the kiss on the page becomes the kiss of eternal life.

Over the last few weeks we have had a few incidents at Church with items going missing we think we know who is responsible; it's someone a bit down on life and themselves; with this in mind, and the nervousness attached we will postpone our Quarant Ore for a couple of weeks until Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July and the weekend. By then I hope our friend will have moved on and be leaving us alone. What is essential is that people put their names down for watching to make sure the Blessed Sacrament is not left alone and unguarded. Slips are at the back of Church today if you would like to have a named candle like last year.

Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifferences whereby He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners.
