Today's Gospel is an answer to a very simple question: who is this Jesus we follow? What is he like? He tells us himself: he is gentle, and humble of heart. There is a simplicity about this Gospel which speaks very clearly to tired hearts. Indeed, it is often the case that we overlook the simplicity of the Gospel message - which is why it is valuable to be as children, constantly wondering and marveling at the beauty and fascination of Jesus. How much God must love us: the message of salvation is so easy to receive, the promise is so welcome. This is a Sunday to wallow in the wonder of a God who is "kind and full of compassion."

This weekend we welcome Fr Jan Klaver MHM to our Parish. Fr Klaver will be making the 5-yearly APF- Mill Hill thank you and appeal for new members. He will explain how we can all be involved in the Mission of the Church in our homes and families. Jesus asks his followers to 'go and bring the Good News to all people'.
