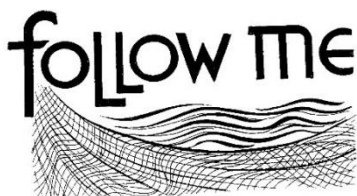


STAY WITH US LORD ON OUR JOURNEY

Mass page 122, creed page 11, Eucharistic Prayer 3 page 27

A quick glance at last week's Gospel reveals the interesting development of the story: last week, we heard Peter proclaiming that Jesus was the Messiah, and being given authority as a result. This week, Peter gets it wrong: he is rebuked by the Lord because he does not understand who the Messiah is. The Messiah is the one who will give everything for his people- even his own life. To be follower of Jesus demands an understanding and acceptance of this fact, and a willingness to take up the cross as

Jesus did. Our introduction to this is the prophet Jeremiah - also persecuted for doing and saying what was right. Have a look at the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, where this twinning of Jeremiah and prophecy of persecution also appears.
