Today we have another Resurrection event, when Jesus sits down with his disciples having prepared breakfast for them. It had been an eventful morning for them because they had caught nothing, but they paused listened to the voice calling to them and brought finished up with a great catch. This is a reminder to us all that we can turn around moments of emptiness if we let the Lord touch us and speak to us; then catch we haul in can be overwhelming. Of course patience and perseverance are what are needed, and being able to sit awhile and chew over things with Jesus. We can tell him our story and he is the one who can make something of all our loose ends of life. So listen up to the Lord and let him surprise you! I was

listening to a remarkable story on the radio the other morning about a young woman aged 29, who was desperate for a lung transplant; her condition worsened, and she found herself in a coma. Two or three days later she woke up, with her parents and immediate family around the bed, she thought she had died, but her mother kept saying to her that a donor had been found at literally the last second, and she was really alive. She was being interviewed a year later, she had had a remarkable year, and one of her delights was being able to take her dog for a walk, which had been impossible before. She was thankful and immensely humbled by the generosity of the person who had died and the family that had consented to the sharing of organs for the benefit of others; their loved one had died, but in their death they brought life to others. It's just thought: I have a donor card, have you? It's good to know that when Lord comes calling for me, perhaps there is a possibility that my death may bring life to another. God Bless mjk
